

Camp Hours and Fees

Drop-off is at 8:30. Camp begins at 9:00. The door will remain locked until 8:30 so please do not drop your child off before that time. Pick-up is at 4:00. Because our days are packed with scheduled activities, it is important that our Campers arrive on time. It is equally important that Campers are picked up on time as many of our Counselors have second jobs they need to get to. Thank you for helping us stay on time!
