



## Pavilion Rules and Regulations

- ✚ City beaches are open from 6:00 AM - Midnight (City Resolution 88-6-6)
- ✚ City Code allows alcoholic beverages in public parks until 9:30 PM
  - 3.15. Same—Possession or consumption prohibited in certain public places. It shall be unlawful for any person to possess or consume alcoholic beverages, between the hours of 9:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. in any public park, playground, recreational area, or athletic field owned, leased, or rented by the City of Charlevoix.
- ✚ The playing of music is regulated by the following sections of the City Code. If the City Police receive a complaint from a neighbor that the music is too loud, you may be asked to turn the speakers down.
  - (3) Sound Amplifiers. Use of any loudspeaker, amplifier or other instrument or device, whether stationary or mounted on a vehicle for any purpose except one which is noncommercial in character and when so used shall be subject to the following restrictions:
    - (e) The volume of sound shall be controlled so that it will not be audible for a distance in excess of one hundred (100) feet from the sound amplifying equipment and so that the volume is not unreasonably loud, raucous, jarring, disturbing, or a nuisance to persons within the area of audibility.
    - (9) Radio and Musical Instruments. The playing of any radio, television set, phonograph, or any musical instrument in such a manner or with such volume, particularly during the hours between 11 o'clock P.M. and 7 o'clock A.M., or the making of any such noise at any time so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of persons in any school, place of worship, or office, or in any dwelling, hotel, or other type of residence, or of any persons in the vicinity.
- ✚ Although we do our best to have picnic tables under each pavilion, we cannot guarantee the number of tables at any given time as they get moved around.

- ✚ The use of nails, tacks, screws, and the like to hang signs or decorations is prohibited. There will be a minimum fine of \$25 if this occurs.
- ✚ The power outlets are for small appliances only.
- ✚ Trash receptacles are available in each pavilion. You are responsible for cleaning up after your event.
- ✚ Fires of any kind are prohibited. This includes in the pavilion, on the adjoining property and on our beaches.
- ✚ Charcoal grills are available at each of our pavilions. You are responsible for making sure the coals are completely cooled before leaving.
- ✚ Food trucks/catering is allowed. A list of local restaurants is available by calling 231-547-3253 or emailing [betha@charlevoixmi.gov](mailto:betha@charlevoixmi.gov).
- ✚ The resident rate is defined as a taxpayer in the City of Charlevoix, or a renter within the City of Charlevoix who is also registered to vote in the City.
